SPARKLING CIDER

Cidre Brut is a sparkling dry cider that has been made by the Desfrièches family for more than 100 years. They grow heirloom French cider apple varieties on their farm, which are hand harvested. Secondary fermentation in the bottle results in the sparkling cider.

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CHARMAT METHOD

The Charmat method is a sparkling winemaking process that traps bubbles in wine via carbonation in large steel tanks. This technique is also called metodo Italiano, the Marinotti method, the tank method, or cuve close ("sealed tank," from the French cuvée, or vat)

RADIKON

In the Friuli region of Northern Italy, the history of skin contact wines goes back hundreds of years. Radikon is an exemplary representation of beautiful winemaking that can come from this area where tradition trumps national borders. Radikon is not necessarily a traditionalist however. Rather than using ancient vinification vessels such as anfora (terra cotta clay vessels), all of their wine is vinified in Slavonian Oak barrels (famously used in Piedmontese wines as well). These funky and fun gems have a cult following so try 'em out and see what the fuss is all about!

Namazakes are unpasteurized, meaning the enzymes are still alive in the beverage and so it must be kept and served cold. Namazakes are one of the most exciting categories of sake styles as they are vivacious, complex, usually off-dry and just a bit more exciting than most of the other sake styles...

The Takachiyo Namas are extremely rare and highly sought after Namazakes that focus on single rice varietal strains; a very uncommon practice among Sake producers. Only a few cases of each make it to Texas each year!
